

EUROREGIONAL RESIDENCY FOR AUTHORS

As part of the <u>Euroregional Green Audiovisual Hub</u> project, KSIgune - Basque Higher Education & Research Cluster for CCIs; CLAVNA - the Audiovisual Cluster of Navarre; and Pôle Image Magelis in Angoulême, collaborate to develop a residency programme for authors to support writing projects in animation in the Euroregional territory.

Objective

The objective of this partnership between Basque Country, Navarre and New Aquitaine is to welcome 3 authors in residence, one from each region, during 3 weeks (with one week in each territory).

This residency is for authors of animation projects, located in the 3 aforementioned territories and within the limit of one project per author. Legal entities (companies, associations, etc.) are excluded from this programme.

Residency grant

During the residency, they will be able to benefit from the support of professionals (production, direction, studio management, renowned scriptwriters, etc.). to advise on their writing project.

Each author will receive a grant of 2,000 euros, paid by KSIgune, CLAVNA or Pôle Image Magelis respectively, following the selection process of each region.

In addition, their accommodation, lunch meals (except weekends) and travel will be covered.

A room and suitable equipment will be made available to them during their residence in each of the partner territories.

Schedule

- Launch of the call for projects: 28 October 2024
- Deadline for submitting applications: 10 December 2024
- Announcement of the selected authors: 31 January 2025
- Residency arrangements: February 2025 (organisation of travel, accommodation and work agenda)



- Residency weeks:
 - New Aquitaine (Angoulême) : 3-7 March 2025
 - Navarre : 10-14 March 2025
 - Basque Country : 17-21 March 2025

Eligibility

To be eligible, authors must:

- Be a resident of any of the 3 territories mentioned in this call
- Be interested and willing to liaise with other authors in Spanish, Basque, French or English
- Be committed to and available to participate in the residency (3 weeks in total, one week per territory)
- Have a script project in development

To be eligible, projects must meet the following criteria:

- Be written in the language of the territory
- Be for cinema or television (all target audience will be considered equally)
- Be animation projects
- Be in the start-up or rewrite phase

Applications must include:

- A motivation letter regarding the expectations for the residency & the preferences and preferences of the profile of professionals to support their writing process
- A description of the project and target audience
- A synopsis of minimum 3 pages
- A CV of the author (both more experienced and novice profiles will be considered)

Sustainability criteria

The Euroregional Audiovisual Green Hub partners are committed to contributing to the sustainability of the sector, and they will apply the environmental sustainability criteria for the travel and accommodation arrangements, as well as for the approach and support provided for the development of the residency and the writing process.
